Tasting Notes

102 Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

The great cool triangle of fertile land between Padthaway, Coonawarra and Langhorne Creek grows most of Australia's best Cabernet Sauvignon. This is classic Cabernet Sauvignon from Padthaway: rich, red, healthy, appetising wine!

The 102 South Australia Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 is a healthy, juicy, vibrant young red with good fresh fruits adorning a base of firm preserving tannin and acidity. This wine has been made with carefully-selected oak, to add aroma and flavour to the preserving tannins which occur in the skins and pips of the grapes. The wine is delicious to drink now, in its youth, but will mature and soften beautifully if kept in a cool dry place or good cellar.

This 102 South Australian Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 is delicious wine to have with duck, chicken and pork dishes. It is also a luxurious relaxing refreshment for anytime of the afternoon or evening.
